<u>Trade, Employment and Labour Standards</u> provides the first comprehensive analysis of the issue. Do countries with low levels of labour standards gain an unfair trade advantage over countries with high standards? What is the relationship between labor standards and economic development? What are the advantages and disadvantages of possible mechanisms to promote labor standards?

Policy Implications for Ageing Populations examines the effects of ageing on pensions, health and long-term care, and labor and capital markets and describes current thinking about directions for reform in each of these areas. It also considers the fiscal effects of major reform scenarios (and of keeping the status quo) and the obstacles to reform and outlines possible next steps in developing the new policy framework.



Examples range from the fuel economy of automobiles (and the distances people drive them), or the energy required to make a ton of cement, to various indicators which describe the effects on national energy use of improvements in efficiency of more than two dozen energy users. The book addresses how changes in the structure of the economy are related to energy use.
