This paper evolved from work done by the authors under a research contract with the California Air Resources Board (ARB) completed in July 2014 as "Report of the Market Simulation Group on Competitive Supply/Demand Balance in the California Allowance Market and the Potential for Market Manipulation." During 2012 and 2013, the authors received compensation from ARB under that research contract. Staff at ARB reviewed and commented on that report before its release in 2014, but final editorial control was solely with the authors. Staff at ARB have not reviewed later revisions that evolved into this paper.

Since 2015, Borenstein has served on the Advisory Council of the Bay Area Air Quality Management District, which provides scientific advice on air pollution regulatory issues faced by the management and Board of Directors of BAAQMD. Since 2019, Borenstein has served on the Board of Governors of the California Independent System Operator.
