I, Brenda Samaniego de la Parra, hereby declare that I have no relevant material or financial interests that relate to the research described in this paper. I received two grants to support the tasks of linking administrative and survey data for this project: one from the UC Santa Cruz Dolores Huerta Research Center for the Americas (UC RCA) and another from the University of California Institute for Mexico and the United States (UC MEXUS). Neither one of these parties reviewed this manuscript nor do they have any material or financial interest related to its contents.

This paper uses restricted access data from three different sources in the Mexican government: the National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI), the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare (STPS), and the Mexican Institute of Social Security (IMSS). IMSS data was accessed through Banco de México’s EconLab, an initiative that makes data available to researchers. Banco de México, STPS, and INEGI each have clear guidelines for researchers to request access to the data. We provide additional information on these procedures in the README file.

As part of the requirements to access IMSS’s data, I signed a confidentiality agreement with Banco de México. Per the agreement, Banco de México reviewed the results and draft only to ensure no identifiable information was released and to guarantee adherence to confidentiality requirements. INEGI also reviewed empirical results contained in the manuscript that were based on the data we accessed at their premises. The manuscript’s results, views, and conclusions are exclusively the responsibility of the authors and do not necessarily reflect those of Banco de México, IMSS, INEGI or STPS.
